February was a busy month for the wastewater department. We spent the better part of the month recovering from the inclement freezing weather. Even with much effort from the contractor to mediate the conditions, the site has remained fairly muddy. Despite the unfavorable conditions, crews have been working to quickly finish renovating the existing basin and wrap up the project. Grading of the site has been ongoing for nearly a month, but rainy conditions have made it an uphill battle. We incurred (1) permit exceedance this month. It occurred while we were still experiencing higher than usual flows due to ice melt and ground saturation. Having experienced a critical equipment failure during the weather, the biological process was still recovering when we began experiencing extra flow. All combined it pushed us to the limit and resulted in the violation. We have since recovered particularly well, owing to both warmer weather, and our growing understanding of how to run the plant to achieve the best treatment. We're feeling more confident in our understanding than we have since the transition. There has still been no word from the State on whether we will be fined, per the Director's order, for the violations incurred during the inclement weather.

Other News: In February, there was a lot more progress with the new park. One field is now complete with sod and is starting to grow. We met with the site supervisor to pick out paint colors for the bathrooms and concession stand, along with, picking out the counter top colors. They tested out the irrigation system, and it is working great. They have started sod on another field and that should be done very soon. It looks like they are finishing dirt work on the last two fields to get sod started on those. Last month I also met with someone about laying out a nine hole disc golf course. We were able to find locations for all nine holes and I am hoping to get that project going very soon. This should add another attraction to our new park and give our citizens something else to do in town. We also have registration for soccer going on right now, and will get those practices/season started by the end of March.

The Oakland Fire Department responded to a total of (134) calls of need from the last reporting date.

The Fire Department did respond to several winds driven grass fires and two working structure/House fires during the reporting period.

This is now the time each year that we start the Towns fire/safety inspections, at the time of reporting we have completed (117) inspections and having to act against one business for gross safety/fire violations forcing their closing for one week to give them the time needed to bring the structure into code. I would like to give thanks to the Oakland Code Department for their assistance in this matter.

The Oakland Fire Department has just completed testing for the Rank of Firefighting Lieutenant, this testing consisted of

1. A written exam for job knowledge
2. A peer review
3. Interview
4. a working practical exam of scenarios and personnel problems that they may face in the command role.

This type of testing will now become the standard that will be used as a benchmark to select the best candidates for promotion and will be used to form an out of rank list for future use.

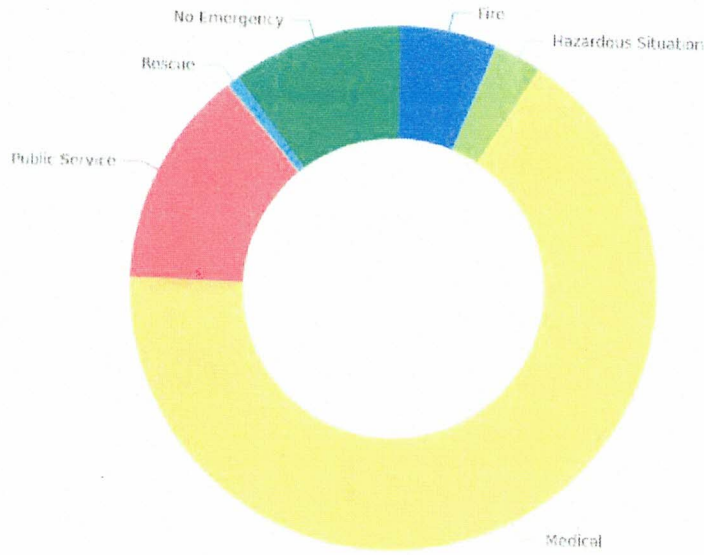
On 3/12/2026 we will be meeting in Somerville with members from Tennessee Department of Transportation about the expansion of the HELP program into Fayette County on our roadways.
